The Baptist Children's Village is a Christ-centered ministry whose focus is to help children and their families fully understand and experience the healing ministry of Christ by meeting their daily needs.

Children have been cared for since 1897 and have grown to a statewide ministry that includes seven residential campuses. The BCV provides quality care for about 200 children every year. The BCV is the official child care agency of the Mississippi Baptist Convention. Our Headquarters is located in Ridgeland, Mississippi at 114 Marketridge Dr.

Questions:

HOW OLD ARE THE CHILDREN?

We have children in our care from Birth to 20.

FROM WHERE DO YOUR CHILDREN COME?

Many children come as a result of private placements, by families themselves seeking help. Children are also referred by public child protection agencies and pastors.

WHERE DO CHILDREN WORSHIP AND ATTEND SCHOOL?

Children worship at host churches in the community where their residential campus is located. Children attend public school in the community where their campus is located.

ARE THE CHILDREN ALLOWED TO VISIT WITH THEIR FAMILIES?

All visits are planned in advance. Residents may visit off-campus one or two week-ends a month.

WHAT DOES IT COST TO PLACE A CHILD?

We do not charge families a fee. We often ask the family to invest in the welfare of their child's financial care if they have the ability to do so.
